RULES AND REGULATIONS

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

A very important thing that everyone in attendance at the Freedom of Rock Fest needs to understand is: **WE CAN ONLY HAVE ALCOHOL BECAUSE OF THE PINE CREEK TOWNSHIP VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY LIQUOR LICENSE!** PLCB will be there to verify Pennsylvania Alcohol Rules are being followed. They do have the authority to shut down the consumption of alcohol if rules are not followed. The Board Members of the Freedom of Rock Fest are planning on having this event continue for years to come. Help us make this a Great Music Festival and raise money for Local Breast Cancer Patients. Thank You!

Alcoholic Beverages can be brought into the Jefferson County Fairgrounds **ONLY** if you have a RV Site with Hookups, Primitive RV Site or Tent Site. You can **ONLY** have Alcoholic Beverages in the RV and Tent Site areas and nowhere else. **NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES CAN BE BROUGHT INTO THE STAGE VENUE AREA. THIS INCLUDES THE 10 X 10 POPUP TENT AREA.** There will be 1 Alcohol Vendor at Freedom of Rock Fest, Pine Creek Township Volunteer Fire Company. They will be serving 6 to 8 varieties of Draft Beer and Straub Sangria, a Fruity Spritzer. 16 Ounce Beers will be \$3.00. If you are repeatedly caught bringing your own alcoholic beverages into the Stage Venue and 10 X 10 Popup area you will **BANNED FROM THE PREMISES FOR THE REST OF THE 3 DAY EVENT.** If you don't have an RV Site or Tent Site, you will not be allowed to bring Alcoholic Beverages into the Fairgrounds PERIOD.

We want everyone in attendance at the Freedom of Rock Fest to come and have a good time, enjoy the music and have fun with friends and family. Eat, Drink and be Merry in moderation and enjoy the Freedom of Rock Music Fest! Please Drink Responsibly. Thank you for your support!

UNDERAGE DRINKING/WRISTBANDS

There will be a Zero Tolerance for Underage Drinking. Underage Guests will be required to have a Parent or Guardian sign a consent form for you to attend. If an Underage Guest is caught Drinking, you and your Parent or Guardian that signed for you will both be asked to leave the Fairgrounds and you will not be welcome back. Underage guests will be wearing special color wristbands so that they can be spotted easily by Security and Staff. If you see Underage Drinking, please report it to Security or Staff Members.

Everywhere in the Fairgrounds you are required to have a wristband on. If you are not wearing a wristband you will be escorted to where your wristband is to put it on or to the Security Tent so you can pay to be at the Event. If you are at the Event without a wristband and do not want to purchase one you will be escorted out. If you try to reenter the Fairgrounds Property, we will call the State Police and prosecute you for trespassing.

WHAT TO BRING

This is a Cash & Card Event. You can use Cash or Card to make all purchases at this Event including Food Vendors. We will have an ATM Machine onsite near the Security Tent where Event Shirts & 50/50 Tickets will be sold.

Essentials such as Portable Lawn Chairs, Easy Up's, Sunscreen, Sunglasses, Rain Gear, Fully Charged Cell Phone and Portable Chargers are all acceptable items to bring into the Venue area.

WHAT NOT TO BRING

Golf Carts, Side by Sides, Minibikes, Small Dirt Bikes, and all other Motorized or Battery Off Road Vehicles are not permitted in the Fairgrounds except those being used by Event Staff. There will be Golf Carts available for Handicap Persons.

Professional Equipment such as Professional Camera Equipment for Pictures or Video, Professional Recording Equipment are all not permitted in the Venue Area. Cell Phones are the only thing permitted to take Pictures and Videos.

Fireworks, Aerosol products such as Hairspray, Spray String and Air Horns, Balloons, Beach Balls, Frisbees, Drones, Remote Control Vehicles, Illegal Drugs, Drug Paraphernalia and Laser Pointers are all not permitted in the Venue Area.

Due to our Insurance Regulations, there are **NO PETS** of any type permitted anywhere in the Fairgrounds during the entire Event.

Weapons of any type including Pistols, Rifles, BB Guns, Soft Air Pellet Guns, Paint Ball Guns, Straight Blade Knives, Swords and anything else that can be used as a Weapon are all Prohibited in the Fairgrounds.

BEHAVIORIAL ETIQUETTE

Be Respectful to EVERYONE at the Music Event, this includes disrespecting or taunting the Bands, walking through RV or Camping Sites. Simply treating all others how you would like to be treated.

Stay off the Stage unless you invited to go on Stage by a Staff Member, stay out of the Pit Area in front of the Stage, don't try to go backstage to see or talk to Band Members, don't throw objects at Band Members or the Stage, be respectful to Band Members when they are making their way to or from the Dressing Rooms.

When the Bands are done for the Day and it is past Midnight, please be respectful to those Camping around you and keep the noise at a tolerable level in and heading to your Camping area.

RV SITES & TENT SITES

There is a Trash Crew that comes through the RV and Tent Sites at least once daily. Please put your trash in trash bags and place them near the gravel road. Our Trash Crew works very hard and will be picking up any trash bags you leave after you depart.

You are allowed to have ABOVE GROUND CAMPFIRES. You are not allowed to have a Campfire on the ground. Please dispose of your ashes in a trash bag after they have cooled down completely. Do not Burn anything other than Wood.

All RV and Tent Campers will be issued a Parking Permit when you arrive. Please Park your vehicle in your RV Site or Tent Site. If you don't have room in your site, then please park somewhere nearby ensuring that you are not impeding in someone else's RV or Tent area. Just be neighborly.

This is a Rain or Shine Event, there are no Refunds for Tickets, RV Sites, Tent Sites, T-Shirt Sales and all Game of Chance Sales (50/50).

Most important of all, please leave your RV Site or Tent Site the way you find it or cleaner and nicer. Thank you.
